Numeracy



The Circles and Squares will be extending their knowledge of place value when working with decimal fractions. They will develop skills in multiplying and dividing decimals by a single digit. They will also be simplifying and solving algebraic equations.

The Triangles will be identifying and comparing common fractions. They will find the fraction of an amount and relate it to division. They will also estimate and measure volume using millilitres and litres.

Expressive Arts

Drama - We will be working on our improvisation and role play skills through our topic and class novel 'Holes'.

Music - We will be developing skills in listening and appraising a range of music linked to our topic.

Art - Our topic will create opportunities for pupils to develop their knowledge and skills in colour mixing and shading.



Literacy

Reading - This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through a variety of texts including our class novel 'Holes'. We will be working in groups and independently to further our understanding of skills covered.

Writing - Our focus this term is to up level our writing. We will focus on the features of writing a recount.

Talking and Listening - The pupils will be engaging with attention and listening lessons. They will be developing their skills in active listening.



Topic - Our topic this term is Endangered Animals. We will discuss the impact of human activity, climate change and weather on habitats around the world.



Science - We will be investigating the classification of living and non-living things.

RME - We will focus on the Jewish festival of Purim and the story of Esther discussing the key themes.

ICT - We will develop skills in researching the internet and word processing which will link to our topic Endangered Animals.

Homework

Homework task boards will be given out each month, covering 4 weeks of homework. This may include a mixture of Literacy, Numeracy, Outdoor Learning and Health and Wellbeing. We ask that 2-4 tasks are completed per week. Any written work can be put into homework jotters and brought into school to be marked.
