At Elderbank Early Years we highly value parent/carer partnerships and want you to be fully involved in your child's learning journey. We will continue to use Seesaw as a communication tool to ensure parent/carers receive regular updates on events and information relating to the Early Years and individual updates about your child's experiences. Please use this as a two-way communication tool and share information from home or ask any questions.



Your child's Keyworker will soon be sharing their 'Personal Learning Plan' (PLP) with you which provides you with the learning targets they will be working on over the coming term. The targets have been identified based on your child's current stage of development and identifies the milestones they will be working towards through a play based learning approach. You will have the opportunity to view the targets, comment on them and contribute to the parent/carer plan if you have any targets you would like child to experience. If you have any questions related to the plan please do not hesitate to ask.
