Health and Wellbeing

Our P.E. days are Thursday and Friday.

We will focus on gymnastics, rugby and social dancing.

Expressive Arts

Numeracy:

The Triangles group will explore multiplication and division of the 3, 4 and 10 times table. We will also be working on fractions and identifying equivalent fractions.

The Square group will understand the concept of multiplication and repeated addition. We will recite the two times table with accuracy and link division facts. We will also explore 2D and 3D shapes.

The Circle group will focus on addition and subtraction number bonds to 20. We will also work on fractions through finding halves and quarters. Time will be studied by sequencing events in the day and identifying minutes in an hour.

<u>RME</u>: We will be exploring the Hindu festival of Diwali. We will also explore religious stories about Christmas and how Christmas is celebrated throughout the world.

<u>Science</u>: The children will participate in a variety of S.T.E.M challenges. We will focus on choosing appropriate materials to solve design challenges.

Literacy

<u>Reading</u> - This term we will explore SHORS reading comprehension strategies. We will also further develop our reading comprehension skills through our novels and Bug Club books.

<u>Writing</u> - This term we will be focussing on writing a description and an information report using our PM writing resource.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> - This term we will be focussing on active listening and using strategies to engage an audience in a presentation.
