Health and Wellbeing

Literacy

Outdoor Learning

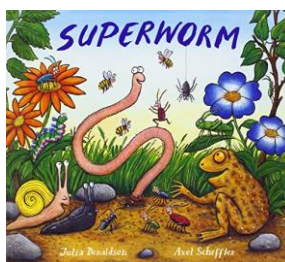
