



Health and Wellbeing

Our focus for Health and Wellbeing this term will be continuing to develop our emotional wellbeing through Emotion Works. We will be working to identify the triggers and body sensations related to our emotions.

In PE we are developing our hockey skills before moving on to social dance. Our P.E. days are Wednesday and Friday.



Expressive Arts

Drama - We will be working on our improvisation and role play skills through our topic.

Music - We will be developing skills in listening to and performing a range of music linked to our topic.

Art - Our topic will give us opportunities to develop a range of skills, including the use of tone and shade using sketching pencils, pastels and charcoal.



Numeracy



Circles will be learning how to accurately measure and draw angles using appropriate equipment. Also, they will be describing 3D objects and 2D shapes, using mathematical language.

Squares will be working with decimal fractions, extending their knowledge of place value involving tenths, hundredths and thousandths.

Triangles will be developing their understanding of the link between compass points and angles. As well as this, they will be investigating and identifying the multiples and factors of numbers.

Literacy

Reading - This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through a variety of texts including our class novel, working in groups and independently to further our understanding of issues covered.

Writing - Our focus this term is to up level our writing. We will focus on the features of writing a description and an information report.

Talking and Listening - The children will be progressing with their group discussion skills, justifying opinions and reasoning with others.

Topic - Our topic this term is World War 2. We will be investigating the impact of World War 2 in Britain. We will research and explore how World War 2 began, The Blitz, the evacuation and rationing.

Science - We will be investigating electricity and energy.

RME - This term, we will focus on the Christian festival of Christmas and how it is celebrated around the world.

ICT - We will be working on using search engines, finding reliable online sources and distinguishing between primary and secondary resources during research.

Homework

Homework will be given out using a four weekly grid. This may include a mixture of spelling, literacy tasks, topic research and tasks, numeracy tasks and reading.
