Health and Wellbeing

Our P.E. days are Thursday and Friday.

We will focus on gymnastics, hockey and dance.

As part of our Health and Wellbeing topic we will use Emotion Works to re-visit the red and green cogs where we will continue to explore emotion behaviours and body sensations. We will also explore the yellow cog focussing on emotion triggers. As part of our SHANARRI focus we will continue to discuss and explore the features of a healthy and active lifestyle.

Expressive Arts

Music -



We will listen to and discuss the features of traditional Scottish and Australian music.

Art -



We will explore the work of a variety of Scottish Artists such as Charles Rennie Mackintosh to incorporate texture, line and tone in our work. We will explore a variety of Australian themed art.

Drama -

This term we will be expressing our ideas on cultural diversity through verbal and non-verbal role play.

Numeracy:

The Triangle group will focus on multiplying and dividing by 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 9 and 10. We will also explore place value within 999 ordering, sequencing and comparing numbers.

The Square group will understand, recognise and use the terms kilogram and grams. We will explore time and study hours in a day and minutes in an hour. We will also link division facts when looking at repeated addition and multiplication.

The Circle group will explore place value for tens and units. We will also focus on and estimating and measuring volume and identifying lines of symmetry.

RME: We will be exploring the Christian festival of Easter and Holy week. We will discuss and identify different customs and traditions of how Easter is celebrated around the world.

Science/Technology: The children will participate in a variety of S.T.E.M challenges. In ICT we will focus on graphics by inserting shapes and clip art, resizing them and using the scribble tool and ruler.

Literacy

Reading - This term we will continue to explore SHORS reading comprehension strategies. We will also further develop our reading comprehension skills through our novels and PM books.

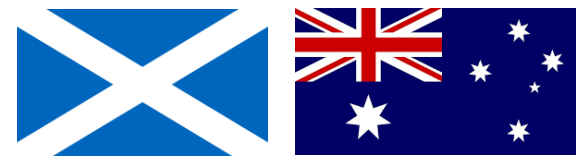
Writing - This term we will be focussing on narrative poetry, procedural and exposition writing through our PM writing.

Talking and Listening - This term we will be focussing on developing our presenting and note taking skills. We will learn the poem 'Nessie' by J.K Annand for Burns Week and share our learning with the class.



Topic

Our topic this term will be a comparative study between Scotland and Australia. We will explore the similarities and differences between culture, landscape and environment. We will also investigate the main features of weather, climate and discuss the impact of this on living things.
