Health and Wellbeing:

Our P.E. days continue to be on Tuesday and Thursday. This term, we will focus on hockey, badminton and basketball.



As part of Health and Wellbeing, we will be learning how to respond and react to unsafe situations and emergencies. We will also continue learning about living a Healthy lifestyle, including hygiene and preparing healthy foods.

Expressive Arts:



In music, we will learn about some traditional Scottish music and instruments.



In art, we will be learning about and analysing the work of various Scottish artists. We will then use a variety of methods and media to create our own Scottish themed art.

Homework

Homework continues to be issued on a Monday through Seesaw and will now be distributed in class via a homework jotter. All children are encouraged to complete and return homework.

Numeracy:

We will extend the range of whole numbers we can work with and use these in problem solving.

Squares and Circles - We will be learning about algebra and solving tricky equations.

Triangles - We will be working on place value of numbers up to 3-digits, and finding the values of missing numbers in a simple equation.

Mathematics:

Our focus this term is on measuring the weight of objects in grams and kilograms, using a variety of instruments. We will also learn the rules to convert between these units of measure.



Literacy:

Reading - This term, we will further develop our reading comprehension skills through SHORS and novels. We will explore the use of Scots language within a variety of texts and poems.

Writing - This term we will continue to learn about the features of information report writing before focusing on poetry, narrative and procedural writing.

Talking and Listening - Pupils will learn note taking skills to help with writing reports. We will also learn and perform Scots poetry.



Topic

This term, our topic will be the Scottish Wars of Independence. We will be researching and creating a timeline of significant events using a variety of sources. We will also learn about the lives of historical figures who helped to shape our country.

Outdoor Learning:

Outdoor Learning continues to take place on a Tuesday. Please ensure your child has an appropriate jacket and footwear on this day.

ICT:

In ICT, our focus this term is on the creation and use of spreadsheets.



RME:

This term, we will look at festivals from other world religions and will also learn about Easter customs and traditions around the world.
