Health and Wellbeing


Our P.E. days are Thursday and Friday.

We will focus on gymnastics, hockey and dance.

As part of our Health and Wellbeing topic we will use Emotion Works to re-visit the red and green cogs where we will continue to explore emotion behaviours and body sensations as well as the yellow cog, focussing on emotion triggers. As part of our SHANARRI focus we will continue to explore food and health using different foods and activities.

Art -

We will explore the work of a variety of Scottish Artists such as Charles Rennie Mackintosh. We will discuss and replicate his techniques using different skills. We will also explore different pieces of Australian art.

Drama -

This term we will be expressing our ideas on cultural diversity through verbal and non-verbal role play.

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Numeracy:

The Square group will focus on angles and directions including how to use these in real-world situations. They will also explore the concept of area and how to create and recognise the area of a variety of shapes.

The Circle and Triangle groups will explore numbers to 1,000 including ordering, comparing and reading numbers accurately. They will also focus on multiplying and dividing two-digit numbers using a variety of active techniques as well as worksheets. Finally, they will begin to explore the relationship between the 3 and 6, and 4 and 8 multiplication tables to recall multiplication facts.

<u>RME</u>: We will be discussing the Christian festival of Easter and Holy week. We will explore how Easter is celebrated across the world and delve into different cultures.

<u>Technology</u>: In ICT we will focus on graphics by inserting shapes and clip art, resizing them and using the scribble tool and ruler. We will also practice making our own PowerPoints to present to the class using information from our topic.

Literacy

<u>Reading</u> - This term we will continue to explore SHORS reading comprehension strategies, focussing mainly on questioning and visualising. We will also further develop our reading comprehension skills through our novels and PM books.

<u>Writing</u> - This term we will be focussing on narrative porry, procedural and exposition writing. We will learn about the structure of these before creating our own pieces using PM writing.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> - This term we will be focussing on developing our presenting and note taking skills.





Topic

Our topic this term will be a comparative study between Scotland and Australia. We will explore the similarities and differences between culture, landscape and environment. We will also compare factors such as animals, weather and lifestyle to explore both countries.





Science

P5/4 will be learning about the human body this term. We will be learning the names of lots of different body organs and investigating the role they play within the body.
