Expressive Arts

Drama – We will have fun working on and presenting short dramas, as part of a group, using improvisation or a script.

Music – We will explore a range of instruments and how they can be used to create different sounds, mood and atmosphere.

Art – We will be using collage to express ideas, thoughts and feeling. We will also experiment with different textile techniques.

Numeracy:

We will be looking at everyday contexts in which simple fractions, decimal fractions and percentages are used and carry out the necessary calculations to solve related problems.



We will also explore a range of 3D objects and 2D shapes, using mathematical language to describe their properties and through investigation discuss their practical use within our environment.

Literacy

Reading – This term we will develop our comprehension skills through our reading books and class novel – Matilda by Roald Dahl. We will have a particular focus on concluding, summarising and inferring.

Writing – Our focus this term is Procedure and Expository texts. Pupils will engage with PM Writing to learn how to construct a procedural and instructional writing.

Talking and Listening – This term we will be enjoying Scots poetry. We will read and analyse poems to understand their deeper meaning.

In January, pupils will be provided with a poem to learn and recite with expression as part of our Scots Poetry Recital.



Topic

This term we will be learning about Scotland during World War 1. We will use this as a context to explore what life was like at this point in history and the impact of war on Scotland's people.

Science will allow us to investigate floating and sinking of objects. This will support our understanding of buoyancy to allow us to solve practical challenges.

RME – We will be listening to a range of stories from a wide variety of religions before exploring Easter Customs as we approach the end of the term.

Digital Technologies - This term we will be using Toontastic and other animation and coding programmes to complete exciting digital projects.
