



Health and Wellbeing

Our focus for Health and Wellbeing this term will be continuing to develop our emotional wellbeing through Emotion Works. We will be working to identify the triggers and body sensations related to our emotions.

In PE we are developing our badminton skills before moving on to volleyball. Our P.E. days are Wednesday and Friday.



Expressive Arts

Drama - We will be working on our improvisation and role play skills through our topic.

Music - We will be exploring traditional Scottish music and comparing and contrasting it with contemporary music.

Art - We will explore using a range of media through our topics. This will include opportunities to learn about traditional art from our chosen countries.



Numeracy



Circles will be applying their knowledge of the coordinate system to plot points and describe the location of a point on a grid. They will also be calculating the area and perimeter of squares, rectangles and triangles.

Squares will be extending their knowledge of decimal fractions by ordering, sequencing and performing calculations with decimals. They will also be simplifying and solving algebraic equations.

Triangles will be developing their knowledge of time by reading digital and analogue clocks, using timetables and calculating durations. They will also be using rounding and estimating during mental maths.

Literacy

Reading - This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through a variety of texts including our class novel, working in groups and independently to further our understanding of issues covered.

Writing - At the start of term, we will be looking at poetry and writing some of our own. We will then focus on the features of writing a procedure and an exposition.

Talking and Listening - This term we will be developing our ability to recognise and use Scot's language.

Topic - We will be focussing on Robert Burns at the beginning of term 3. This will involve researching the traditions related to a Burns supper. We will also be exploring a country of our choice. We will look at the geography of the country as well as the cultural customs and look at the similarities and differences with Scotland.

Science - We will be learning about inheritance. We will be investigating inherited and non-inherited characteristics of humans and animals.

RME - This term, we will be investigating how 'Carnival' is celebrated and identifying the traditions associated.

Homework

Homework will be given out using a four weekly grid. This may include a mixture of spelling, literacy tasks, topic research and tasks, numeracy tasks and reading.
