



## Health and Wellbeing

Our focus for Health and Wellbeing this term will be continuing to develop our emotional wellbeing through Emotion Works. We will be working to identify the triggers and body sensations related to our emotions.

In PE we are developing our badminton skills before moving on to volleyball. Our P.E. days are Wednesday and Friday.



## Expressive Arts

**Drama** - We will be working on our improvisation and role play skills through our topic.

**Music** - We will be exploring traditional Scottish music and comparing and contrasting it with contemporary music.

**Art** - We will explore using a range of media through our topics. This will include opportunities to learn about traditional art from our chosen countries.



## Numeracy



Circles and Squares will be continuing to work on calculating the area of a variety of shapes including triangles and composite shapes. They will then develop their knowledge on place value, time durations and 3D shape.

Triangles will also be developing their knowledge of place value and 3D shape as well as developing skills in dividing a two digit number by 6,7,8 and 9.

They will continue to work on improving the accurate recall of all their times tables and apply this to problem solving.

## Literacy

**Reading** - This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through a variety of texts including our class novel, working in groups and independently to further our understanding of issues covered.

**Writing** - At the start of term, we will be looking at poetry and writing some of our own. We will then focus on the features of writing a procedure and an exposition text.

**Talking and Listening** - This term we will be developing our ability to recognise and use Scot's language.

**Topic** - We will be focussing on Robert Burns at the beginning of term 3. This will involve researching the traditions related to a Burns Supper. We will also be exploring a country of our choice. We will look at the geography of the country as well as the cultural customs and look at the similarities and differences with Scotland.

**Science** - We will be learning about inheritance. We will be investigating inherited and non-inherited characteristics of humans and animals.

**RME** - This term, we will be investigating how 'Carnival' is celebrated and identifying the traditions associated with it.

## Homework

Homework will be given out using a four weekly grid. This may include a mixture of spelling, literacy tasks, topic research and tasks, numeracy tasks and reading.
