## Health and Wellbeing



Our P.E. days are Tuesday and Thursday.

We will focus on taking part in a variety of summer games and athletics.

As part of Health and Wellbeing we will be focussing on exploring self-esteem and friendships. We will also explore Sustainable Cities and Communities as part of our Sustainable Development Goal focus.

## Expressive Arts

Music -

We will be exploring the sounds of the rainforest. We will investigate these using our voices, musical instruments and instruments we have created using recyclable materials.



Art -

We will create a variety of art using mixed media based around our topic of the rainforest.



Drama -

This term we will be creating different scenes from the rainforest using improvisation.



## Numeracy :

This term the Squares group will explore identifying the importance of the use of numbers in everyday life and investigating the variety of different systems that have been used by civilisations throughout history to record numbers. We will also add and subtract 2 and 3 digit numbers using a variety of strategies.

The Circle group will explore multiplying 2 and 3 digit numbers using carrying and remainders. We will also explore estimating and measuring the area of a shape.

The Triangle group will focus on building up our times table facts for the 2 times table. We will also discuss and explore the properties of a range of 2D shapes and identify 2D shapes which will tile.

RME : We will be exploring a variety of festivals, customs and traditions across world religions.

Science : We will be focussing on energy by exploring the different types of energy and their sources.

## Literacy

Reading - This term we will continue to explore SHORS reading comprehension strategies. We will also further develop our reading comprehension skills through our class novels, PM and Bug Club reading books.

Writing - This term we will be continuing to use our PM writing resource focussing on creating explanation and discussion texts.

Talking and Listening - We will continue to explore our ORACY skills focussing on active listening, presenting, note-taking, questioning, responding and body language.

## Topic

Our topic this term will be The Rainforest. We will explore the different layers of the rainforest and the animals and plants that live there. We will also investigate the role climate change has had on the rainforest.
