Health and Wellbeing:

Our P.E. days continue to be on Mondays and Tuesdays. This term, we will focus on athletics, summer games and outdoor activities.



As part of Health and Wellbeing, we will be learning about eating diverse foods in a range of social situations. We will also investigate how physical activities and sport can lead to positive destinations.

Expressive Arts:



In Music, we will be given the opportunity to learn how to play the recorder.



In Art, we will be experimenting with a range of materials to make 2D and 3D constructions.

Homework

Homework continues to be issued on a Monday through Seesaw and will now be distributed in class via a homework jotter. All children are encouraged to complete and return homework.

Numeracy:

We will be estimating and rounding 2 and 3 digit whole numbers to the nearest ten and hundred.

Squares and Circles - We will be learning to tell the time to the nearest minute on both digital and analogue clocks. We will also be calculating durations and planning events using timetables and calendars.

Triangles - We will be learning about simple fractions - halves and quarters.

Mathematics:

Our focus this term is on measuring, recording and estimating volume in litres and millilitres. We will also learn to convert between these units of measure.



Literacy:

Reading - This term, we will continue to develop our reading comprehension skills through SHORS and novels.

Grammar - We will focus on identifying common adverbs with the suffix -ly and how they affect the impact of the sentence.

Writing - This term we will be learning about the features of explanation text and discussion writing.

Talking and Listening - Pupils will be learning to distinguish between fact and fiction and will participate in class debates.
