Health and Wellbeing

We will be discussing the physical and emotional changes on the body during puberty, as well as human conception and birth. We will also be discussing substance misuse and identifying the effects this has on the body. Also, we will be developing our awareness of strategies to support us during our transition to secondary school, exploring the importance of positive relationships.

In PE we are developing our athletic skills, teamwork through a variety of games as well as focussing on improving our fitness levels. Our P.E. days are Wednesday and Friday.

Expressive Arts

Music/drama - We will be experimenting with movement, expression and voice. We will be rehearsing a performance which we will showcase to an audience during term 4.

Art - Our topic will give us opportunities to develop a range of skills, including mixing colours in painting and creating clay models.







Numeracy

Circles will be exploring the link between speed, distance and time. Also, they will be conducting simple experiments involving chance and uncertainty.

Squares will be applying their knowledge of the coordinate system to plot points and describe the location of a point on a grid. Also, they will be applying their knowledge of number facts to simplify and solve algebraic equations. Triangles will be working on data and analysis, interpreting and drawing conclusions from information. Also, they will be ordering, comparing and converting fractions.

<u>Literacy</u>

<u>Reading</u> - This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through literature circles, focussing on developing SHORS and using a variety of texts chosen by pupils.

<u>Writing</u> - We will be using our writing skills to write a big book 'My Olympic Dream'. We will write a chapter each week. At the end of the term, we will create an attractive cover then read our books to the younger pupils.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> - We will be applying our Oracy skills to deliver a group presentation with a focus on using a clear voice, expression and gesture.

Topic - We will be focussing on the Paris 2024 Olympic Games this term. This will include researching the origins of the Olympics as well as exploring the range of sports that compete.

Science - We will focus on properties of substances and separating materials. We will investigate how changes in substances can produce other substances. We will be exploring processes such as filtration, evaporation, burning, heating and cooling.

RME - This term, we will be exploring the 'Five Pillars of Islam' and developing our knowledge of Pilgrimage.

Homework

Homework will be given out using a four weekly grid. This may include a mixture of spelling, literacy tasks, topic research and tasks, numeracy tasks and reading.
