Health and Wellbeing



During PE lessons, we will be learning the skills from summer games such as batting, throwing, catching and aiming to a target. We will take part in a variety of team games and develop our communication skills.

In our Health and Wellbeing lessons, we will focus on building our self esteem. We will discuss and share positive attributes of our peers and ourselves. Throughout term 4, we will continue to work on adding and subtracting within 20 and develop fluency when recalling numbers bonds to 10. We will be focusing on counting forwards and backwards within 20 and 30 and recognising numbers beyond 20. Moreover, we will be learning to create symmetrical pictures, sequence the days of the week and describe the

of objects using a range of measuring devices.

<u>Reading</u> - This term we will be reading a selection of non-fiction and fiction books. We will be focusing on developing our recall of sight words and recognising them within a text. We will also continue to learn phonics single sounds, blending them together to read words.

<u>Writing</u> - We will be focusing on writing a simple sentence that includes a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop. We will develop independence when writing by using word banks and 'have a go' strategies.

Through play experiences, we will be continuing our topic of 'Our Local Community' and exploring places of interest to us. We will also be learning about space and the solar system and as part of this, we will create various pieces of artwork using a range of materials.
