Health and Wellbeing

Our gym days will continue to be Tuesday and Thursday this term. We will be exploring gymnastics this term during our PE lessons, covering rolls, jumps, while moving like different animals. This term we will be learning about healthy foods. We will be continuing to develop our skills in preparing food safely with a focus on hand washing before and after meals. This term we will also be continuing to brush our teeth.



Literacy



We will be continuing to explore the ORT Family 'Biff, Chip, Kipper, Floppy, Mum and Dad'. We will develop our skills by matching full sentences to pictures, some will be sequencing and ordering what happens 'First, Next and Then' in stories. We will be reading stories about Biff, Chip, Kipper and Floppy in class.

Maths

We will be exploring shapes during our Maths lessons this term. We will develop an awareness of shapes, recognising and naming 2D shapes. We will investigate shapes and ways to sort them by their features and where we find them all around us. We will create shape based art throughout the term.



Religious and Moral Education



New beginnings! With the coming of the Spring season and our celebration of the Earth, we will be exploring creations stories from around the globe. We will develop an awareness of the world and different cultures and relationships. While exploring stories from 6 major religions we will focus on respect and friendship.

Interdisciplinary Learning
