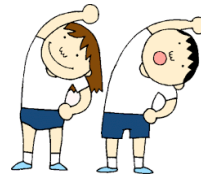


# Primary 3M - Term 4 Newsletter

## Health and Wellbeing

This Term, P.E. will focus on Athletics, 'Invasion Games' and physical fitness. Within Health and Wellbeing, we will be exploring the importance of positive relationships and friendship. We will also continue to develop emotional wellbeing and resilience using a variety of resources including Emotion Works. P3M will be active outdoors as we further develop our practical skills and knowledge in camping, outdoor materials and cooking.

## Literacy



In writing, P3M will be focusing on creating 'Explanation' and 'Discussion' texts. We will continue to work on improving our skills through planning, spelling, punctuation and grammar. Primary 3 will develop their reading skills using different media, PM resources, SHORS, our reading books for practice at home and novels to enjoy as a class. We will promote our Talking and Listening using the skills and knowledge we developed in our Term 3. We will be using a range of individual, paired and group learning.



## Science

In Science, we will be studying Materials and Dissolving, which will focus on material properties and soluble/insoluble substances.

## Religious and Moral Education

This term, P3M are looking forward to focusing on the celebration of 'Shabbat'. We will concentrate on the history of particular religions and their development, and experience different aspects of a religious festival.

## I.C.T.



We will continue to focus on general ICT skills, such as using email and Internet Safety. Primary 3 will also develop their skills in web search using different devices and website navigation.

## Numeracy



Within our three working Numeracy and Mathematics Groups, we will cover:

- Numerical and Mathematical Vocabulary
- 2, 3 and 4 place value (Th, H, T, O)
- Four Operations (+, -, x, ÷)
- 2D shape - tiling
- Problem Solving - Number patterns, reasoning, visualising and working backwards.
- Data and analysis using tables, graphs and spreadsheets

## Inter-Disciplinary Learning

Our IDL topic this term is 'Finding Nemo', through which we will explore aspects of Health and wellbeing: relationships, emotions, inclusion, sea life and climate.

## Expressive Arts



In Drama: There will be opportunities to use role-play within the classroom and shared area. P3M will continue to use games and role-play activities to further develop drama skills. We will also focus on performance and presenting.

In Art & Design: Our focus will be on Texture and Form, within which we will explore how to make models, sculptures and use textiles. We will continue to exhibit our work to our peers and will develop our evaluative skills when observing artwork.

In Music: We will continue to progress our singing skills, with a particular focus on pitch and dynamics. There will also be opportunities for musical instrument practice.
