

Health and Wellbeing




We will focus on taking part in a variety of summer games and athletics.

Numeracy:

This term the Triangle group will use our times table facts to multiply and divide 2 and 3 digit numbers with carrying and remainders. We will explore the terms 'clockwise' and 'anti-clock wise' when turning through right angles. The triangles will also be organising and using a calendar for information.

The Square and Circle groups will explore multiplication and division of the 3, 4 and 10 times table. They will use this knowledge to identify fractions and find a third, a quarter, a fifth and a tenth of 1 and 2 digit numbers within the 3, 4, 5 and 10 times table. We will use the terms numerator and denominator and identify where simple fractions are located on a number line.

<u>RME</u>: We will be exploring a variety of festivals, key figures and traditions across world religions.

<u>Science</u>: We will be focussing on food chains and eco systems related to our topic of the rainforest.

<u>Technology</u>: We will access glow and create spreadsheets.

Literacy

<u>Reading</u> - This term we will continue to explore SHORS reading comprehension strategies. We will also further develop our reading comprehension skills through our novels and PM books.

<u>Writing</u> - This term we will be continuing to use our PM writing resource focussing on creating explanation and discussion texts.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> - We will continue to explore our ORACY skills through our characters. We will focus on active listening, presenting, note-taking, questioning, responding and body language.





Topic

Our topic this term will be The Rainforest. We will explore the different layers of the rainforest and the animals and plants that live there. We will also investigate the role climate change has had on the rainforest.
