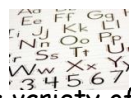


Health and Wellbeing

Literacy



Reading - This term we will be looking at a variety of whole class stories and individual reading books where we can look at key questioning and constant practise to help comprehension, fluency and blending of phonics.

Writing - We will be exploring lots of different mark making techniques. Through formation of letters, art, using a variety of media and sentence writing.

Talking and Listening - Pupils will be encouraged to join in discussions using their preferred method of communication.

Numeracy

In Numeracy, will continue to extend their individual targets in number. We will also concentrate on looking at shape, position and movement and number processes by looking at numbers before, after, between and addition and subtraction.



Broad General Education

This term we will be looking at Community and housing. This will involve trips into the school community and the pupil's own community.
