Health and Wellbeing



Our P.E. days are Wednesday and Friday.

We will focus on the different aspects of physical fitness.

As part of Health and Wellbeing we will be learning about The Rights of the Child to create our class charter. We will also explore positive relationships, road safety and hygiene.

Expressive Arts

Music -



We will identify the different instruments used to compose a piece of music that represent a variety of emotions.

Art -



We will be using a range of media to create a variety of objects and images. We will also be doing a variety of art activities based around our topic of 'Charlotte's Web'.

Drama -



We will use our HWB topics and themes from 'Charlotte's Web' as a stimulus. We will be focusing on talking with expression when taking on the role of a specific character.

Maths:

The Triangle and Square group will explore multiplication facts for the 3, 4, and 5 times tables. We will utilise these facts to help us divide. We will use our division skills to understand fractions and use the terms numerator and denominator.

The Circle group will explore money and recognise the use of all coins and notes. We will use mental strategies when calculating change. We will also identify units of measure and put items in order of weight. The terms 'more than, less than and same as', will be understood in terms of measurement.

RME: This term we will focus on the special buildings linked to different religions. We will learn about the key features of a Synagogue and what happens in a Mosque.

Science: We will be learning about parts of a plant, different plant types and environments where plants grow.

Literacy

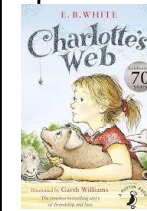
Reading - This term we will further develop our reading comprehension skills through our topic novel 'Charlotte's Web', our group novels and PM books. We will also explore SHORS reading comprehension strategies.

Writing - This term we will be continuing to use our PM writing resource. We will focus on recount and information report writing.

Talking and Listening - We will develop our listening and talking skills through a variety of attention and listening games and activities. We will focus on being able to take turns to speak, listening to others and asking our peers questions.

Topic

Our topic this term will be a novel study on Charlotte's Web. We will explore farming and different animals that live there. We will also focus on friendship and personality traits of the different characters that make us all unique and special.
