Numeracy

The Squares group will be focussing on calculating the area of rectangles and squares. We will also explore ordering and sequencing numbers up to and beyond 1000000.

The Circle group will explore multiplying 2 and 3 digit numbers using carrying. We will divide 2 and 3 digit numbers with remainders. We will also explore showing and telling the time in minutes to and minutes past the hour using analogue and digital displays.

The Triangle group will explore the 6, 7, 8 and 9 times table and use our multiplication facts to help us divide. We will also discuss and identify patterns and links within and between multiplication tables.

Literacy

<u>Reading</u> - This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through a variety of texts including our class novel 'Wonder' working in groups and independently to further our understanding of issues covered.

<u>Writing</u> - Our focus this term is to up level our writing. We will focus on the features of writing a recount.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> – The children will be engaging with attention and listening lessons. They will be developing their skills in active listening, questioning and responding.



Health and Wellbeing

Our focus for Health and Wellbeing this term will be building confidence and developing a positive mindset. We will complete a range of activities from 'Emotionworks' to support this. We will also be exploring feelings which will give us vocabulary to express how we feel and how to seek advice and support if we need it.
