Health and Wellbeing

This term we will work on building a class community and learning about the UNCRC rights. As part of this we will look at friendships and identify the qualities we would like to see in a friend. In PE we will work on co-operating with others during team games and small ball skills. Our PE days are Monday and Wednesday.

Expressive Arts



Art & Design

We will be learning about primary and secondary colours. We will be mixing paint to make secondary colours.

Drama

We will be learning to use mime, movement, voice and expression to create, develop and sustain a given role/character.

Music

We will explore rhythms using different untuned percussion instruments. .



Numeracy and Maths

We will be recording addition and subtraction calculations vertically and rounding two digit numbers to the nearest 10. We will be continuing to work on numbers to at least 100, counting forwards and backwards as well as developing quick recall of number bonds. In addition to this, we will begin to solve simple word problems. In our maths lessons, we will be identifying a range of 3D objects and describing their properties.

Science

This term we will be learning about how characteristics are inherited between generations and how some features of a person can change over time.



Literacy

Reading - We will be reading various texts in class and asking and answering questions about what we have read. We will continue to develop our recall of common words and identify these within a range of texts.

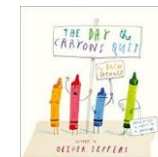
Writing - We will be learning to create sentences which include the correct punctuation and will begin to add description to our writing.

Talking and Listening - We will work on how to be a good listener and a more confident speaker. We will think about how to behave when others are talking and understand what a quality audience looks like.
