Health and Wellbeing

Our focus for Health and Wellbeing this term will be building confidence and developing a positive mindset. We will complete a range of activities from 'Emotionworks' to support this. We will also look at being a good friend which is a focus in our class novel.

P.E

In PE we are developing our team building skills in netball and our agility and balance through gymnastics.

P.E. days are Tuesday and Thursday.

Expressive Arts

Drama - We will be working on our improvisation and role play skills through our class novel.

Music - We will be developing skills in listening and appraising a range of music linked to our class novel and topic.

Art - Our topic will create opportunities for the children to look at different artists' work. They will discuss their thoughts and feelings about different pieces of art as well as creating their own artwork inspired by what they have learned.

Numeracy

Hexagons and Squares

The Hexagons and Squares will be focusing on adding and subtracting two and three digit numbers.

They will look at different strategies and be able to discuss which strategies they are using. They will also look at solving word problems. They will work on knowing their times tables up to the ten times table, off by heart.

Triangles

The Triangles will be focusing on dividing two digit numbers by 2,3,4 and 5. They will also look at using remainders, After that, they will be focusing on reciting the 6,7,8 and 9 times tables with increasing accuracy. They will look at the links between multiplication and division, being able to recognise patterns and links.

Literacy

Reading - This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through a variety of texts including our class novel 'The Boy at the Back of the Class', working in groups and independently to further our understanding of issues covered.

<u>Writing</u> - Our focus this term is to up level our writing. We will focus on the features of writing a recount. We will also work on improving our handwriting.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> - We will be engaging with attention and listening lessons. We will be developing skills in active listening.

Topic - Our topic this term is the Paralympics.

Science - We will look at an investigation into the effects of fertilisers on the growth of plants linking in with our class novel.

RME - We will focus on the Jewish festival of Pesach.

ICT - We will develop our presentation skills using PowerPoint including inserting text and images.



Homework

Homework task boards will be given out each month, covering 4 weeks of homework. This may include a mixture of Literacy, Numeracy, Outdoor Learning and Health and Wellbeing. We ask that 2-4 tasks are completed per week. Any written work can be put into homework jotters and brought into school to be marked.
