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Numeracy

Circles will be exploring the place value of numbers up to, and beyond, a million. They will be deepening their understanding of the relationship between 3D objects and their nets.

Squares will be developing their knowledge of volume, converting between different units of measurement. Also, they will be analysing trends in presented data.

Triangles will be applying a variety of strategies when adding and subtracting. As well as this, they will be exploring symmetry in 2D shapes.



Literacy

<u>Reading</u> - This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through a variety of texts, working in groups and independently to further our understanding of issues covered.

<u>Writing</u> - Our focus this term is to up level our writing. We will focus on the features of writing a recount.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> - The children will be engaging with attention and listening lessons. They will be developing their skills in active listening.



Health and Wellbeing

Our focus for Health and Wellbeing this term will be building confidence and developing a positive mindset. We will complete a range of activities from 'Emotionworks' to support this. We will also be exploring feelings which will give us vocabulary to express how we feel and how to seek advice and support if we need it.

In PE we are developing our skills in Basketball and our agility and balance through gymnastics. P.E. days are Monday and Friday.



Topic - Our topic this term is France. We will look at the geography of the country as well as the cultural customs. We will be highlighting the similarities and differences with Scotland.

Science - We will be learning about planet Mars and will investigate the question 'Is life sustainable on Mars?' We will be investigating gravity, water in space, growth of plants and examining the landscape.
