Health and Wellbeing

We have changed our gym sessions to Tuesday and Thursday so please make sure pupils have a kit in their bag or at school. In gym, we will be focusing on learning that repeated practice improves movement skills, through station work and different energetic games. Literacy



<u>Reading</u> - We will be looking at blending at each child's individual level to help pupils learning single sounds or sound families.

<u>Writing</u> - We will be focusing on building on hand stamina to help with sentence writing, formation of letters. We will be building our hand strength through lots of fine motor skill activities, writing and arts and crafts.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> - Pupils will be using table top games and activities to join in social communication where pupils can discuss experiences and interests.

Outdoor Learning



The Adventurers will be continuing our Outdoor Learning through creating natural habitats and Den building. We will use natural materials down in the woods to create natural dens with wood, mud and sticks. We will promote pupil's independence by getting them to pick correct outer wear clothing to correspond with the weather. Can we ask for pupils to bring in correct clothing i.e. scarf, hats and gloves on cold days.
