## Literacy

In Literacy, we are building on our fine motor skills and taking part in sensory activities and exploration to encourage this. We are exploring objects using our senses as well as printing and mark making through a range of materials and media. Pupils are discovering how to use a writing implement such as a paint brush as well as learning how to make more meaningful marks.



## Numeracy

In Numeracy, we will be continuing to develop our knowledge of time, using our 'Time for...' clock. Some of the children will work on developing an awareness of 'start and finish' times while other pupils will start to recognise that different activities happen at different points during our school day. We will also introduce a calendar into our morning welcome routine, where pupils will have the opportunity to choose and talk about the date, day and month.

## Health and Wellbeing

In Health and Wellbeing, we are continuing to focus on relationships both in the classroom and in our outdoor learning environments. Staff will model and encourage opportunities for play on an individual basis and with their peers. We are also discovering how to take turns and share. As well as relationships, we will be building on our knowledge of weather appropriate clothing, modelling how to wear warmer clothing as the weather turns colder.
