Health and Wellbeing

Our P.E. days are Wednesday and Friday. We will focus on gymnastics, rugby and social dancing. As part of our Health and Wellbeing topic we will use Emotion Works to re-visit the orange emotion words cog. We will also explore the green emotion behaviour cog and red body sensations cog. As part of SHANARRI we will focus on healthy bodies and nutritional needs.

Expressive Arts

Music - We will listen to and play music related to Knights and Castles. We will also learn how to sign a Christmas songs using B.S.L.



Art - We will be doing a variety of art activities based around our topic of the Knights and Castles. We will focus on using the visual elements of line, shape, form, colour, tone, pattern and texture.

Drama - In drama we will take on different roles using movement, expression and voice linked to our Knights and Castles.



Numeracy:

The Triangles group will continue to explore equivalent fractions. We will understand and use the terms litre and millilitre and identify the uses of measuring equipment. We will also plot a location on a grid and describe the position. The Square group will explore multiplication and division of the 3, 4 and 10 times table. We will also be working on fractions and identifying equivalent fractions. The Circle group will focus on addition and subtraction number bonds to 20. We will also work on fractions through finding halves and quarters. Time will be studied by sequencing events in the day and identifying minutes in an hour.

RME: We will be exploring the Hindu festival of Diwali. We will also explore religious stories about Christmas and how Christmas is celebrated throughout the world.

Science: The children will participate in a variety of S.T.E.M challenges. We will focus on choosing appropriate materials to solve design challenges.

Literacy

Reading - This term we will explore SHORS reading comprehension strategies. We will also further develop our reading comprehension skills through our novels and PM books.



Writing - This term we will be focussing on writing a description and an information report using our PM writing resource.

Talking and Listening - This term we will be focussing on active listening and using strategies to engage an audience in a presentation.

Topic

We will be studying Knights and Castles. Our aim will be to research the purpose of knights and castles and the significance of them in our history.
