Health and Wellbeing:




Our P.E. days are Tuesday and Thursday. We will focus on gymnastics, rugby then Social Dance.

Numeracy:



We will be consolidating the use of the four operations through function machines and the order of operations.

We will be learning about how to read/interpret from charts and graphs, as well as developing our own surveys to create a chart/graph. We will use ICT software to display information on charts and graphs.

We will also be measuring and converting in centimetres and metres to calculate lengths.

French:
