#### Numeracy:



We will continue working on our multiplication and division strategies to support out knowledge and application when taking on problem solving challenges.

Pupils will also be learning to convert analogue and digital time as well as calculate time durations. Pupils will have the opportunity to explore real world examples such as bus timetables, store opening times and much more.

# Literacy

Reading – This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through our reading books and class novel – The Light Jar by Lisa Thompson.

We will have a particular focus on sequencing, finding similarities and differences in a text and predicting.

Writing - Our focus this term is description texts. Pupils will engage with PM Writing to learn how to construct a description stance point.

Talking and Listening - Pupils will be encouraged to deliver a presentation or talk to their classmates on a

chosen topic. Presentations will take place in front of the whole class or a small aroup and will promote positive talking and listening skills.





Topic – we are starting to explore Climate Change and the impact on endangering animals, as we delve deeper into our topic, considering the direct and indirect effects we are having on our planet.

Science will allow us to study local and global impacts of climate change. Through experimentation, we will investigate the oceans as absorbers of heat and why carbon dioxide is useful.

RME – We will be learning about the Jewish festival of Hanukah and as Christmas time approaches we will be looking more in depth at the meaning behind Advent.

Digital Technologies - This term we will be using Scratch Programming software to develop our computer programming skills. We will familiarise ourselves with the basic functions of Scratch before progressing onto tasks such as animating characters and creating our own computer games!
