#### Numeracy

Circles and Squares will be exploring a variety of 3D objects, describing their properties and constructing nets. Also, they will be developing their knowledge of 12 and 24 hour time. The skills learned will be applied to a range of practical activities using timetables and calculating durations. As well as this, will be extending their knowledge of decimal fractions.

Triangles will be identifying 3D objects and investigating these in the environment. They will be developing their knowledge of 12-hour time on both analogue and digital clocks. Also, triangles will continue to apply mental maths strategies across a variety of concepts.

## Literacy

<u>Reading</u> - This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through a variety of texts including our class novel, working in groups and independently to further our understanding of issues covered.

<u>Writing</u> - Our focus this term is to up level our writing. We will focus on the features of writing a description and an information report.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> - The children will be progressing with their group discussion skills, justifying opinions and reasoning with others.



# Health and Wellbeing

Our focus for Health and Wellbeing this term will be continuing to develop our emotional wellbeing through Emotion Works. We will be working to identify the triggers and body sensations related to our emotions.

In PE we are developing our skills in Hockey and then moving on to social dance.

Topic - We will look to finish our Comparative Study across the first two weeks of term two, building towards a learning showcase to celebrate all that we have learned. Further, the children will select a pupil-led 'mini topic' based on their own interests.

Science - We will be learning about the different aspects of STEM, looking at how science, technologies, engineering and mathematics are relevant in the world today, focusing on key skills within each area.
