


Numeracy

The Squares group will be focussing on calculating the area of cubes and cuboids. We will also explore identifying the properties of a variety of 3D objects and reading, writing and telling the time using 24-hour times.

The Circle group will be showing and telling the time in minutes to and minutes past the hour. We will also estimate and round 2 and 3 digit numbers to the nearest ten and nearest hundred.

The Triangle group will continue to explore the 6, 7, 8 and 9 times table facts linking these to division. We will also explore using the terms 'clockwise' and 'anti-clockwise' when turning through right angles.

The Rectangle group will explore counting in 2's, 5's and 10's and building up times table facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. 

Literacy

Reading - This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through a variety of texts including our class novel, working in groups and independently to further our understanding of issues covered.

Writing - Our focus this term is to up level our writing. We will focus on the features of writing a description and an information report.

Talking and Listening - The children will be progressing with their group discussion skills, justifying opinions and reasoning with others.



Health and Wellbeing

Our focus for Health and Wellbeing this term will be continuing to develop our emotional wellbeing through Emotion Works. We will be working to identify the triggers and body sensations related to our emotions.

In P.E. we are developing our skills in hockey and then moving on to social dance.

Our P.E. days are Monday and Friday. Please ensure your child has a clean gym kit and shoes on the given days.



Topic - We will look to finish our comparative study of Scotland and France across the first two weeks of term two, building towards a learning showcase to celebrate all that we have learned. The children will then select a pupil-led 'mini topic' based on their own interests.

Science - We will be learning about the different aspects of S.T.E.M, looking at how science, technologies, engineering and mathematics are relevant in the world today, focusing on key skills within each area.

RME - This term, we will focus on the Christian festival of Christmas and how it is celebrated around the world.

Expressive Arts

Drama - We will explore emotions through drama in small groups, exploring how we feel and respond in situations. We will also link our drama inputs with our class topic.

Music - We will be experimenting with beats and rhythms, using musical instruments to follow music and create some of our own.

Art - Our topic will give us opportunities to develop a range of skills, including the use of tone and shade using sketching pencils, pastels and charcoal.
