## Health and Wellbeing

Our focus for Health and Wellbeing this term will be to understand the importance of having a balance of activity, rest and sleep to maintain good health. We will also be able to recognise the role that different food groups play in keeping us healthy.

In PE we are continuing to develop our agility and balance through gymnastics. We will also learn some social dances. Our P.E. days are Tuesday and Thursday.

## RME

We will be learning about the customs and symbols of Christmas.

## Expressive Arts

Music - In Music we will learn some of instruments found in an orchestra and group them in their sections.

Art - Our topic will give us opportunities to further explore a range of media and to develop different art techniques.

Drama - In drama we will continue to use characterisation techniques to convey a character.



## Numeracy:

### Triangles

We will be focusing on adding and subtracting two and three digit numbers. We will look at different strategies and be able to discuss which strategies we are using. We will also explore lines of symmetry.

### Squares

We will be focusing on fractions. We will recognise how fractions are related to division and be able to understand the terms numerator and denominator.

### Circles

We will explore creating and solving word problems including those related to money. We will also develop our understanding of the terms metre and centimetre and use these when measuring length.



## ICT

We will learn to create and edit text in a document using font, size, style, colour, cut, copy & paste.

## Literacy

Reading - This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through our group novels and PM books. We will also use SHORS reading comprehension strategies.

Writing - We will focus on descriptive writing and creating an information report. We will continue to develop our use of VCOP to up level our writing.

Talking and Listening - This term we will be developing our talking and listening skills through showing an understanding of notes that we have created by explaining them to others.

## Topic

This term we will be studying Knights and Castles. Our aim will be to research the purpose of knights and castles and the significance of them in our history.



## Homework

Homework grids will be given out using a four weekly grid. All activities will be discussed in class. This may include a mixture of Literacy, Numeracy, Outdoor Learning and Health and Wellbeing. We ask that 2-4 tasks are completed per week. Any written work can be put into homework jotters and brought into school to be marked.



## Outdoor Learning

Outdoor learning will take place every Monday. Please make sure your child has an appropriate jacket and footwear.
