Health and Wellbeing

We will be focusing on friendships and relationships, so please send in photos of family and friends through Seesaw so we can discuss this in class. Gym is Tuesday and Thursday where we will be looking at ball and racquet skills. We will also concentrate on life skills through cooking.



Literacy



Reading - This term we will extend pupil's learning through continuing to look at phonics. We will be focusing on sight and environmental words that will support with life skills.

Writing - This term we will be focusing on increasing pupil's dexterity through dough disco, spreading, cutting and other fine motor skill activities.

Talking and Listening - Pupils will be encouraged to join in discussions using their preferred method of communication.

Numeracy

In numeracy will continue to extend their individual targets in number. This term we will look at data through charts and pictographs, measuring and in number work we will look at numbers to 100.



Interdisciplinary Learning
