Health and Wellbeing

This term we will continue to support the children in taking turns with staff and their peers in a variety of indoor and outdoor opportunities. They have all been fantastic at starting to take responsibility for their personal belongings and we will continue to encourage this. In PE, we will start to introduce different ball skills including rolling and throwing.

Numeracy and Maths

The children will be looking at money and identifying different coins. We will also look at opportunities to visit the local shop to put our knowledge into practice. They will continue to work on their number processes by looking at identifying 'how many' and what happens when we add one more to a group of items. The children will be offered number experiences through play-based opportunities, songs, digital technology and outdoor learning.



Literacy

In Literacy we will use their reading books to explore sounds, letters, words and different characters. They will carry on using interesting materials for writing to support pencil control and letter formation. We continue to use a total communication approach to enhance the children's communication skills through spoken language, visuals, Makaton, and communication devices.

Inter-Disciplinary Learning

Our topic this term is looking at energy sources and electricity. We will cover how to stay safe when using electricity and we will explore different toys to see what makes them work. It is also the 10th anniversary of Elderbank Primary School opening so we will be celebrating this. Finally, we will look at seasonal celebrations including Burns night, Chinese New Year and Easter.
