Health and Wellbeing

Our focus this term is on Health. We will be learning about the importance of a healthy diet, exercise and quality rest in our day to day lives.

Expressive Arts

Drama – We will have fun working on and presenting short dramas, as part of a group, using improvisation or a script.

Music – We will explore a range of instruments and how they can be used to create different sounds, mood and atmosphere.

Art – We will be using collage to express ideas, thoughts and feeling. We will also experiment with different textile techniques.



Welcome to P6 as we move into a new year and a new term. Here you will find an outline of what we will be learning in Term 3.

Numeracy:

We will be looking at everyday contexts in which simple fractions, decimal fractions and percentages are used and carry out the necessary calculations to solve related problems.



We will also start to explore simple algebraic equations. This will be an opportunity for us to apply our knowledge of number facts to solve problems where an unknown value is represented by a symbol or number.

Literacy

Reading – This term we will develop our comprehension skills through our class novel. The main comprehension strategies we will focus on are predicting, summarising and concluding.

Writing – Our focus this term is Procedure and Narrative texts. Pupils will engage with PM Writing to learn how to construct a procedural text and structure narrative writing.

Talking and Listening – This Term we will be enjoying Scots poetry. We will read and analyse poems to understand their deeper meaning.

In January, pupils will be provided with a poem to learn and recite with expression as part of our Scots Poetry Recital.



Topic

This term we will be learning about Scottish Mythical Creatures and Legends. We will use this as a context to explore folklore and ignite our imaginations.

Science will allow us to investigate floating and sinking of objects. This will support our understanding of buoyancy to allow us to solve practical challenges.

RME – We will be listening to a range of stories from a wide variety of religions before exploring Easter Customs as we approach the end of the term.

Digital Technologies - This term we will be learning how to access our school e-mail accounts to upload and download documents onto a secure shared area.
