

Numeracy

Circles and Squares will be deepening their understanding of the link between fractions, decimals and percentages. They will be exploring the need for rules in operations and following BODMAS to help solve calculations. Also, they will be applying their knowledge of length to help solve length related problems.

Triangles will be exploring function machines and the relationship between input and output. They will be recognising where fractions are used in everyday life and begin to record, compare and simplify a variety of fractions. Also, they will continue to develop their multiplication knowledge by applying a variety of strategies.



Literacy

Reading - This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through a variety of texts including our class novel 'Divided City', working in groups and independently to further our understanding of issues covered.

Writing - At the start of term, we will be looking at poetry and writing some of our own. We will then focus on the features of writing a procedure and an exposition.

Talking and Listening - This term we will be developing our ability to recognise and use Scot's language.



Health and Wellbeing

Our focus for Health and Wellbeing this term will be continuing to develop our emotional wellbeing through Emotion Works. We will be working to describe the intensity of our emotions as well as possible influences.

In PE we are developing our skills in volleyball and badminton during term 3. We will also be working on our dance skills.

Topic - We will be focussing on Robert Burns at the beginning of term 3. This will involve researching the traditions related to a Burns supper, leading to planning and delivering a Burns supper in school. Following this, we will move on to a new topic 'Elderbank Turns 10' which will involve learning from across the curriculum and lead up to a whole school performance.

Science - In Science, we will be exploring inheritance. We will be investigating the difference between inherited features and non-inherited features in both humans and animals.

RME - This term, we will be investigating how 'Carnival' is celebrated and identifying the traditions associated.

Music - We will be exploring traditional Scottish music and comparing and contrasting it with contemporary music.
