Health and Wellbeing



In Health and Wellbeing this term we will be starting to explore sensory circuits in class in the mornings and at points throughout the day to support children to regulate before transitioning into activities. We have received some new trampettes for the children to use as part of their sensory circuits as well as involving the use of exercise balls, balance beams, a tunnel and objects to throw and catch. The children will also spend lots of time outdoors in the sunshine that this term will hopefully bring. In P.E. we will be focusing on our speed and stamina.

Numeracy and Maths

This term our whole class numeracy topic will be money. We will learn about coins as well as the different ways we can pay for things. We will do lots of role play to get used to handling money and we will visit the local shop to put our skills into practice. Pupils will continue to work on their individual numeracy targets daily while completing their work trays.

Literacy



In term 4 we will read the Katie Morag series of books. We will use the real-life situations in the stories to direct our learning in class and outdoors. We will also focus on the topic of Scotland and Islands through the Katie Morag stories, while touching on modes of transport. Alongside our literacy afternoon activities, the children will continue to work on achieving their individual literacy targets through their daily tray tasks.

Interdisciplinary Learning

Our final topic this year will be The Sea. We will read stories with a seaside theme and learn about the creatures that live in and near the sea. We will talk about the seaside near us, what we can do at the

beach and how to stay safe there. We will also learn about why it is important to look after our beaches and seas and how we can help do that.



Expressive Arts/Technologies

In Term 4 we will create lots of lovely artwork around the seasonal topics as well as our literacy stories and class topic. The children will continue to cook and bake weekly with Miss Coleman, working on using different techniques, following instructions and tasting new foods. We will also be enjoying lots of sensory exploration outdoors, incorporating our 'Seasons' topics and our senses in order to enhance our outdoor experiences.
