Health and Wellbeing

Our gym days will continue to be on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons. This term we will be focusing on athletics and outdoor games during our Physical Education lessons. We will be exploring friendship this term and the qualities which make a good friend. This term we will also be developing our understanding of the life cycles of plants and taking care of our own class plants.



Literacy



During literacy lessons we will continue to develop our phonics skills through daily phonics activities. We will be exploring rhyming as a class, learning to identify rhyming words and generate our own words that rhyme. Through attending and listening games we will be exploring the 'Give me 5' rules of good listening. During grammar lessons we will be learning to identify nouns, verbs and adjectives. We will be up-leveelling our sentences using adjectives.

Numeracy and Maths

During maths, we will be exploring symmetry this term. We will be identifying symmetrical shapes and real life objects. Some of us will be learning to identify shapes with multiple lines of symmetry and draw them using a ruler. This term we will also be exploring volume and capacity. We will be discussing which containers we think will hold more/less liquid. Using both standard and non-standard units of measure we will use various tools to measure the volume of various containers.



Interdisciplinary Learning

This term our topic is 'Summer Camp'. With close adult supervision, we will be learning how to cook using a camp fire. We will develop skills in building tents and shelters using tarpaulin and rope. Through art lessons, we will be learning how dyes are used to create colours and patterns on t-shirts and other items of clothing. We will create our own tie-dye t-shirts using the skills we have learned. During our topic we will also be learning some camp fire songs and participating in team building activities.
