Welcome back Classbase 8! We hope you all had a wonderful Summer and are ready for another busy term ahead.

Literacy

Within Literacy, we will be continuing to build on our communication skills, using digital technologies to support language development. We will read stories as a class and participate in inter-disciplinary learning activities based on these. Furthermore, we will be developing our comprehension skills by answering questions and demonstrating an understanding of our individual tray task books. While some pupils will focus on developing their fine motor skills through sensory and hand group activities, other pupils will continue to work on letter formation or writing activities.

Numeracy



Everyone will continue to individually develop their knowledge and understanding of numbers during tray time. This might include counting objects in a group to exploring written strategies to support addition and subtraction. As a class, we will focus on measurement in Term 1, looking at length, weight and volume using both non-standard and standard units of measurement. We will also start to link our daily timetable to times on the clock.

Health and Wellbeing

Through our topic, People Who Help Us, we will be exploring different job roles of people in our community and how they can help us to stay safe and healthy, such as dentists and police. We will continue to have Gym twice a week and will develop our gross motor skills through themed games and activities weeks such as 'Police Week' and 'Doctor Week'. Please remember to bring P.E. kits! We will spend a lot of time outside, both in the school grounds and out in the local community, please ensure pupils are bringing appropriate clothing and wellies if possible!
