Health and Wellbeing

We have gym on a Tuesday and Friday this year so please make sure pupil have a kit in their bag or at school. Students will be learning basic hockey skills like passing, shooting, and teamwork while playing safely in gym. CB7 will learn basic cooking skills to prepare healthy meals and develop confidence in the kitchen.

Literacy

Reading - This term we will be studying Zog to help our understanding of our interdisciplinary learning. We will explore the story's themes and characters, and create their own text through drawings, sequencing or colourful semantics to deepen understanding and spark creativity.

<u>Writing</u> - CB7 will be using colourful semantics to help their understanding of writing. Some will sequences the pictures and words to build sentences will others will be able to write theirs.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> - We will be using pictures and visual aids to practise talking and listening skills, helping them express ideas and understand others more easily.

Outdoor Learning





We be learning to explore outdoors to find and identify natural items, helping them learn about nature and practice observation skills. To do this will learn different skills in patience, identifying and grouping objects and learning about plants and wildlife. Please remember to provide welly boots so we can go out in all weather.

Numeracy

In Numeracy, we will continue to extend individual targets in number. In CB7 we will continue to learn through data handling, some will look at graphs and tally marks whilst others will focus on grouping activities. We will also be looking at position and movement through activities to learn our left and right and how to follow simple directions.

Interdisciplinary Learning

This term we are learning what things we should not touch or eat to stay safe, and what medicines and harmful substances mean. We will use the book Zog by Julia Donaldson to aid understanding of the topic.



During this term we will also learn about Halloween, Fireworks and Christmas through creative art activities and practical sensory activities like bobbing for apples and dressing up.

Expressive Arts

Music - CB7 will use Charanga to learn music skills like singing, playing instruments, and understanding rhythms and melodies.

Art and Design - We will create artwork inspired by the story Zog, using drawing and painting to express their ideas and imagination. Also we are going to focus on using natural products like leaves to aid
