Welcome back Classbase 8! We hope you all had a wonderful October break and are ready for another busy term ahead. We have lots of exciting topics and seasonal events to cover this term such as Halloween, Bonfire Night, St. Andrew's Day and...Christmas!

<u>Literacy</u>

Within Literacy, some of the pupils are building on their knowledge of punctuation, including how to use full stops and capital letters. They are also developing their knowledge of parts of speech such as nouns, verbs and adjectives. Other groups within the class will focus on how to take part in a reading group e.g. turning the pages and briefly engaging with each page. We will all be developing our listening and talking skills through various games and activities.

Numeracy

After working hard on measurement last term, we will begin to focus on time as a class. We will be linking this to our class's chosen theme, Transport. Pupils will have their own time targets that cover identifying o'clock times, to solving word problems focusing on 5 minute time increments. We will continue to work on our individual numeracy targets too; counting, ordering and rounding numbers. Pupils will also focus on shape, particularly the introduction of 3D shapes, where we will discuss features of 3D shapes such as vertices and edges.

Health and Wellbeing

As a class we will be focusing on hygiene and life skills such as learning about why it's important to use soap and why it's important to brush your teeth. We will continue to participate in gym twice a week and also take part in community visits twice a week. Please remember to bring P.E. kits if possible! CB8 will work on transitioning to and from gym with a particular focus on getting ourselves dressed and undressed independently e.g. putting shoes on, putting trousers on.
