Numeracy

In term 2, we will develop our number sense by investigating multiples, factors, prime numbers and square numbers. We will apply these skills and knowledge to support our work within the 4 operations as we continue to find success in a collaborative working environment.

In mathematics, we will analyse and interpret data using a variety of different graphs and charts. Also, we will explore and scrutinise how data is collected and used in the modern world.

In addition, we will deepen our understanding of the properties of 2D shapes and 3D objects. We will take into consideration different types of triangles, constructing nets of 3D objects and sorting shapes according to their properties.

Literacy

<u>Reading</u> – Throughout this term, we will be applying our SHORS strategies to our class and small group reading novels. Also, we will be reading for information and looking at non-fiction texts related to our topic.

<u>Writing</u> – This term, we will be focusing on writing descriptions, information reports and narrative pieces. Throughout, we will be focussing on editing and up-levelling our pieces of writing to reflect our best work.

Talking and Listening – As part of our topic, we will develop our ability to maintain a role within a discussion whilst identifying techniques, such as questioning, used by effective speakers when engaging with a small audience.

<u>Topic</u>

Our topic in Term 2 will be 'A Journey Around The World'. Through our topic, we will explore a range of cultures and societies, considering the similarities and differences to our own. We will look at significant historical events, the natural environment, weather and climate, and social, political and economic issues. We will develop our skills and knowledge across a range of wider curricular areas such as art and design, music, technologies, outdoor learning and modern languages.

Health and Wellbeing

In P.E., we will grow our skills in hockey by focusing on passing, dribbling and shooting under control and with increasing accuracy. We will be applying our hockey skills in discrete practices and small-sided games.

Also, we will be developing an understanding of the effect of drugs, alcohol, smoking and vaping on the human body. We will be examining the impact of peer pressure and the media in how we feel about different substances.
