## **Health and Wellbeing**

#### **Numeracy:**

We shall continue to work on our multiplication and division strategies to support our knowledge and understanding to support problem solving challenges.

Pupils shall also be learning to convert analogue and digital time as well as calculate time durations. Pupils will have the opportunity to explore real world contexts such as bus timetables, store opening times and much more.

<u>Context for Learning</u> – we are starting to explore Climate Change and as we delve deeper considering the direct and indirect effects we are having on our planet.

<u>Science</u> will allow us to study local and global impacts of climate change. Through experimentation, we will investigate the oceans as absorbers of heat and why carbon dioxide is useful.

RME – We will be learning about the Jewish festival of Hanukah and as Christmas time approaches we will be looking more in depth at the meaning behind Advent.

# **Expressive Arts**

<u>Drama</u> – We will express and communicate our ideas and thoughts in a fun and exciting way through drama.

<u>Music</u> – We will be using our voice and musical instruments to experiment with sound, pitch, melody and rhythm.

<u>Art</u> – We will be using our knowledge of proportion to create portraits and figures. We will also explore a range of materials to produce line, tone and shade in our artwork.

## **Literacy**

<u>Reading</u> – This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through our reading books and class novels. We will have a particular focus on sequencing, finding similarities and differences in a text and predicting.

<u>Writing</u> – Our focus this term will be creating descriptive texts. Pupils will engage with PM Writing to learn how to construct a detailed descriptive pieces of work building on skills developed during Term 1 - Recount.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> — Pupils will be encouraged to deliver a presentation or talk to their classmates on a chosen topic possibly linked with our IDL learning context. Presentations will take place in front of the whole class or a small group and will promote positive talking and listening skills.

<u>Digital Technologies</u> – We are learning to touch type using Microsoft Word this will allow us to develop skills for literacy and we shall use our touch typing to create one of our descriptive
