Health and Wellbeing

Our focus for Health and Wellbeing this term will be learning about a growth mindset and ways to think positively about our learning and skills. We will also make personal goals for ourselves.

P.E

In PE we will be learning different movements and actions through dance and building teamwork skills through hockey. Our P.E. days are Tuesday and Thursday.



Numeracy

This term our main focus will be developing our times table knowledge further by multiplying and dividing by 4, 6 and 8. This will include using mental and written methods.



We will also be continuing to use a 'Thinking Classroom' approach to solving problems.

We will be learning about measuring length using centimetres and metres.

Literacy

Reading - This term we will further develop our comprehension skills through SHORS. We will also be learning to read and explore aspects of Scots poetry.

Writing - We will continue to develop our skills in writing descriptions until the end of January. This will include daily writing as well as a focused weekly writing slot. After that, we use the same format to develop our skills in creating information reports.

Talking and Listening - We will be reciting our class Scots poem, using our skills of projection and expression when performing aloud. We will also be developing our listening skills to be a quality audience.

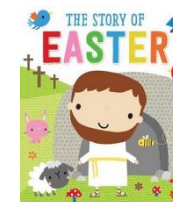


Topic -
