

### **Health and Wellbeing**

Our focus for Health and Wellbeing this term will be learning about a growth mindset and ways to think positively about our learning and skills. We will also make personal goals for ourselves.

### **P.E**

In PE we will be learning different movements and actions through dance and building teamwork skills through hockey. Our P.E. days are Tuesday and Friday.



### **Numeracy**

We will continue to develop strategies to support the 4 process of addition, multiplication and division. We will extend our number range to multiplying by 4, 6 & 8, linking this to division buy grouping and sharing.

We will continue to embed 'Thinking Classroom' approaches to help solve a range of mathematical problems.

We will have the opportunity to carry out a variety of practical measuring activities using a range of tools, measuring in units of meters and centimetres.



### **Topic –**

Our topic this term will be 'The Polar Regions'. As well as exploring the climate, we will compare and contrast the habitats and wildlife in the Arctic and Antarctica.

**RME** – We will learning about the Easter Story its related traditions.

**ICT** – We will develop our coding skills and how to construct a series of instructions to solve a problem.



### **Expressive Arts**

**Drama** - We will be developing our expression and acting skills through our Scottish poem and topic related activities.

**Art** – Our topic will provide opportunities to develop skills using a variety of media as well as distinguishing between hot and cold colours.

**Music** – We will be developing skills in playing tuned percussion instruments to create a piece of music.



### **Literacy**



**Reading** – This term we will further develop our comprehension skills through SHORS. We will also be learning to read and explore aspects of Scots poetry.

**Writing** – We will continue to develop our skills in writing descriptions until the end of January. This will include daily writing as well as a focused weekly writing slot. We will then progress to writing information reports.

**Talking and Listening** – We will be reciting our class Scots poem, using projection and expression when performing aloud. We will also be developing our listening skills to be a quality audience and offer constructive feedback.

Homework tasks will be issued every Monday. This will include a mixture of Literacy, Numeracy, Outdoor Learning and Health and Wellbeing.
