## Health and Wellbeing:



Our P.E. days are Tuesday and Thursday. We will focus on rugby and gymnastics.

We will focus on learning about the importance of having a good energy balance in regards to food intake and physical activity. We will also develop strategies to manage our emotions

## Expressive Arts:

**Music and Drama** - We will develop our music and drama skills together whilst learning about traditional Scottish music during our Jacobites topic.

## Numeracy:

We will be continue to enhance our multiplying and dividing skills and use these to solve a variety of problems in real life contexts. We will also further develop our skills in addition and subtraction with exchange.



## Maths

We will be learning to estimate and weigh a variety of objects using grams and kilograms. We will also use our knowledge of place value to convert weights between grams and kilograms.

We will look at 2D shapes and learn how to calculate their areas and perimeters.

## French:

Our French lessons will focus on the home and describing what can be found in different rooms.

## Literacy:

**Reading** - This term we will continue to develop our reading comprehension skills through SHORS and group reading materials.



**Writing** - This term, we will be learning about the features of descriptive text. We will focus on verb tense and using adjectives to build descriptive passages. We will also be developing our spelling skills by investigating different letter patterns/sounds. Daily opportunities for writing will also continue.

**Talking and Listening** - We will research and deliver a short presentation linked to our topic. We will also develop our Oracy skills.

## Topic:

Our topic this term will be the Jacobites. We will learn about what led up to the rising of 1745 and how the aftermath of the Battle of Culloden affected Scottish culture. We will use the book 'The Reluctant Rebel' by Barbara Henderson as a novel study during this topic.

## ICT:

In ICT, we will be developing our skills to manipulate texts and images using a variety of software. These will be used during class presentations.



## Science:

In Science, we will be investigating the properties of different substances with a focus on dissolving.

We will also explore micro-organisms and classify them into bacteria, fungi and viruses.



## RME:
