Expressive Arts

Numeracy:

We will be looking at everyday contexts in which simple fractions, decimal fractions and percentages are used and carry out the necessary calculations to solve related problems.



We will also start to explore simple algebraic equations. This will be an opportunity for us to apply our knowledge of number facts to solve problems where an unknown value is represented by a symbol or number.

Literacy

Reading – This term we will develop our comprehension skills through our class novel. The main comprehension strategies we will focus on are predicting, summarising and concluding.

Writing – Our focus this term is will continue to be descriptive texts before we move on to procedural writing. Pupils will engage with PM Writing to learn how to construct a procedural text.

Talking and Listening – This Term we will be enjoying Scots poetry. We will read and analyse poems to understand their deeper meaning.

In January, pupils will be provided with a poem to learn and recite with expression as part of our Scots Poetry Recital.



Topic - Pupils will explore extreme weather; investigating hurricanes, tornadoes, floods and more. We will learn about causes, impacts, and safety measures through activities, fostering curiosity and resilience.

Science – Using Extreme Weather as our context for learning, we will investigate extreme weather systems, studying their causes, effects, and the science behind powerful storms like hurricanes and tornadoes.

RME – We will be listening to a range of stories from a wide variety of religions before exploring Easter Customs as we approach the end of the term.

Digital Technologies - This term we will be learning how to access our school e-mail accounts to upload and download documents onto a secure shared area.
