Dear Parents and Carers,

Term 2 has been a busy and exciting time for The Adventurers! We've loved celebrating so many special events, including Halloween, our Coffee Morning, and all things Christmas. ### Health and Wellbeing

Term 3 will bring even more exciting opportunities for The Adventurers. In our PE sessions, the children will continue developing their physical skills with lots of jumping, hopping, skipping, climbing, and balancing. We'll also keep enjoying favourite games such as Bear in the Honey Pot and Duck, Duck, Goose, as the children have loved playing together and are really growing in confidence when taking turns. Whenever the weather allows, we'll continue taking our learning outdoors. The children will have chances to explore the local community through walks and visits to the forest and park.

### Mathematics and Numeracy



In Term 3, The Adventurers will be exploring a variety of maths topics. We will continue to look at splitting objects and sharing them out, before moving on to patterns and relationships. During this block, the children will copy, continue, and create simple patterns using objects, shapes, and numbers. Some children will begin to explore addition and subtraction, while others will continue to focus on recognising numbers and developing their counting skills.

### Literacy/Communication

This term, we will continue to enjoy reading together and sequencing stories. Some children will be reading from reading books independently, while others will focus on looking at pictures and recognising words as an adult reads to them. We will also continue to focus on writing. Some children will be practising writing their first and last names by overwriting or copying, others will continue to write simple CVC words with spaces between them, and some learners will be writing sentences inspired by a picture.



### Diary

Our PE days have now changed to Monday and Friday morning and children should bring soft shoes and shorts to change into. Outdoor Learning will continue on Monday afternoons, and children are welcome to bring a change of clothes or shoes if they wish. We will continue to attend Assembly on Wednesday afternoons.
