Health and Wellbeing

Our gym days will be Wednesdays and Fridays this term. We will be learning to respond to music with our bodies. We will be working towards showing a reaction when the music stops (freezing) and copying actions such as clapping and jumping. During dance lessons we will also be developing our skills in using props such as ribbons and pom poms whilst moving our bodies to the rhythm of the music.



Literacy



We will be exploring a variety of letter sounds using Jolly Phonics songs as a basis, to encourage vocal sounds. We will encounter a variety of themed sensory lessons and mark making to develop fine motor skills including the use of a variety of tools. A continuation of singing nursery rhymes and action songs will give an opportunity for children to join in with learning together.

Numeracy

In Numeracy this term we will be focusing on time. We will use our visuals and objects of reference to follow our daily routines, explore seasons and days of the week. We will continue to practise our number recognition to 5 and encounter counting items one-to-one.



Outdoor Learning



This term we will continue to explore the outdoors, visiting different areas of the school grounds to experience our senses. We will engage in opportunities to include our literacy and numeracy learning outside using the environment around us. We will be accessing the outdoors every day so please ensure you have your wellies so you don't get wet feet!



Interdisciplinary Learning

During this term we will explore a variety of books as part of our topical learning. Through these books, we will participate in a variety of art, literacy, numeracy and health and wellbeing experiences. These experiences will give learners the opportunity to explore a variety of stories, words and senses, whilst encouraging them to engage with books. Additionally, Classbase 10 will explore the changes in seasons from Winter to Spring, taking part in activities that show the transitions while relating it to our numeracy time topic.
