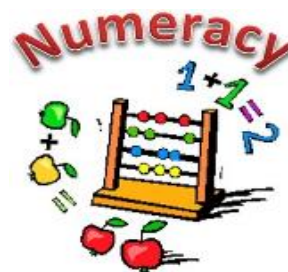
Health and wellbeing

Mathematics

Pupils are supported to develop and extend their personal numeracy skills in accordance with their individual targets in LIPS
